SMURF is a transformative project aimed to provide sustainable and profitable solutions that benefit the entire **European forest-based value chain**

This includes addressing ecological concerns, promoting **economic viability** through wood and non-wood products, and considering the social and **cultural aspects of forest management** with a multidisciplinary approach and inclusive stakeholder engagement.

SMURF is aligned with the **EU's Forest Strategy 2030** and will work over the next **four years** to enable **20 million forest owners across Europe** to generate economic activity and provide employment in forests, while managing forests to conserve and adapt to climate change.

NEW FOREST MANAGEMENT MODELS: CLOSE TO NATURE SILVICULTURE (CNS)

SMURF seeks to broaden European forest management approaches by embracing a variety of models and emphasizing diversification of products and services, promoting biodiversity. Through collaboration with organizations like Pro Silva and Association Forêt Irregulier (AFI), SMURF will develop and implement 11 forest management models for different European forest types, establishing 7 Pilot Study Areas and 11 Demonstration Stands and will try to incorporate them into the Integrate Network.

- 3 Establish innovative management models based on Closer to Nature Silviculture practices (CNS).
- 4 Propose a new standardised Payment for Ecosystem Services system (PES), empashizing carbon and biodiversity criteria.
- 5 Co-create a comprehensive framework to support small-forest owners throug trainings, guidelines and recommendations.

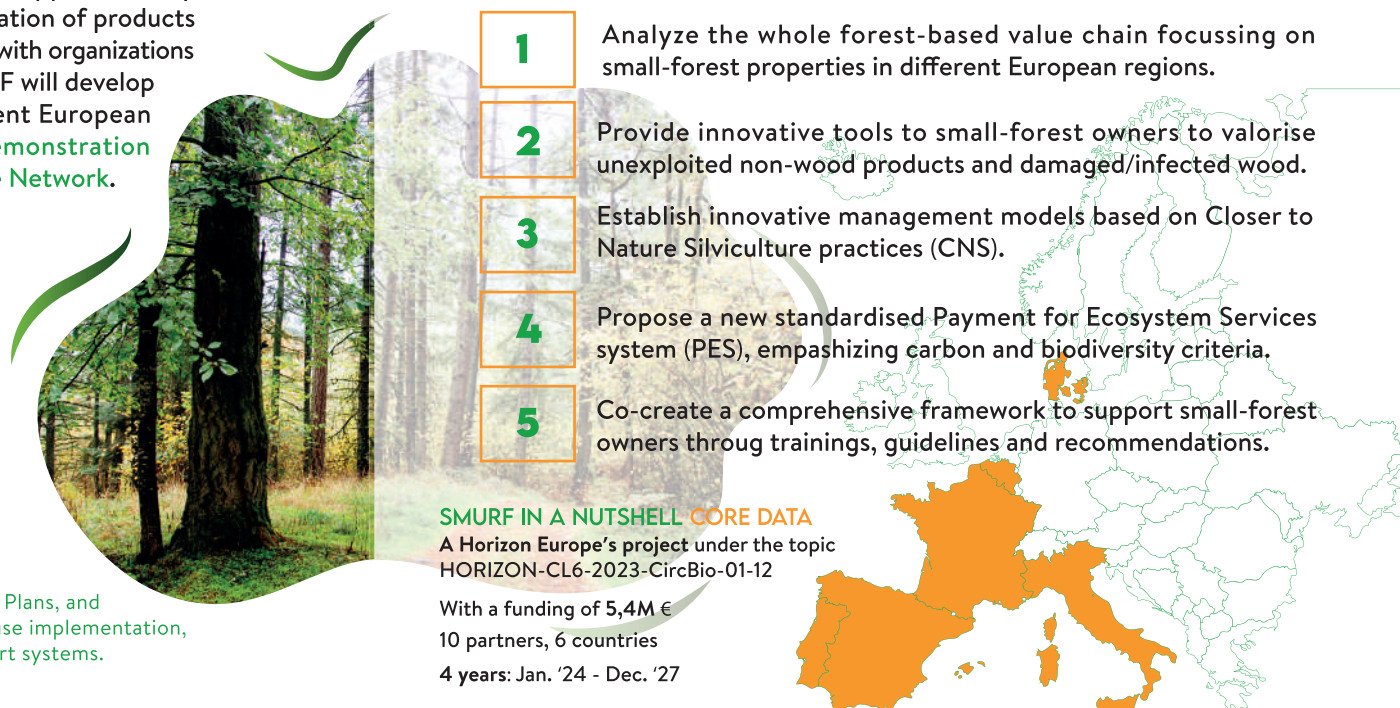

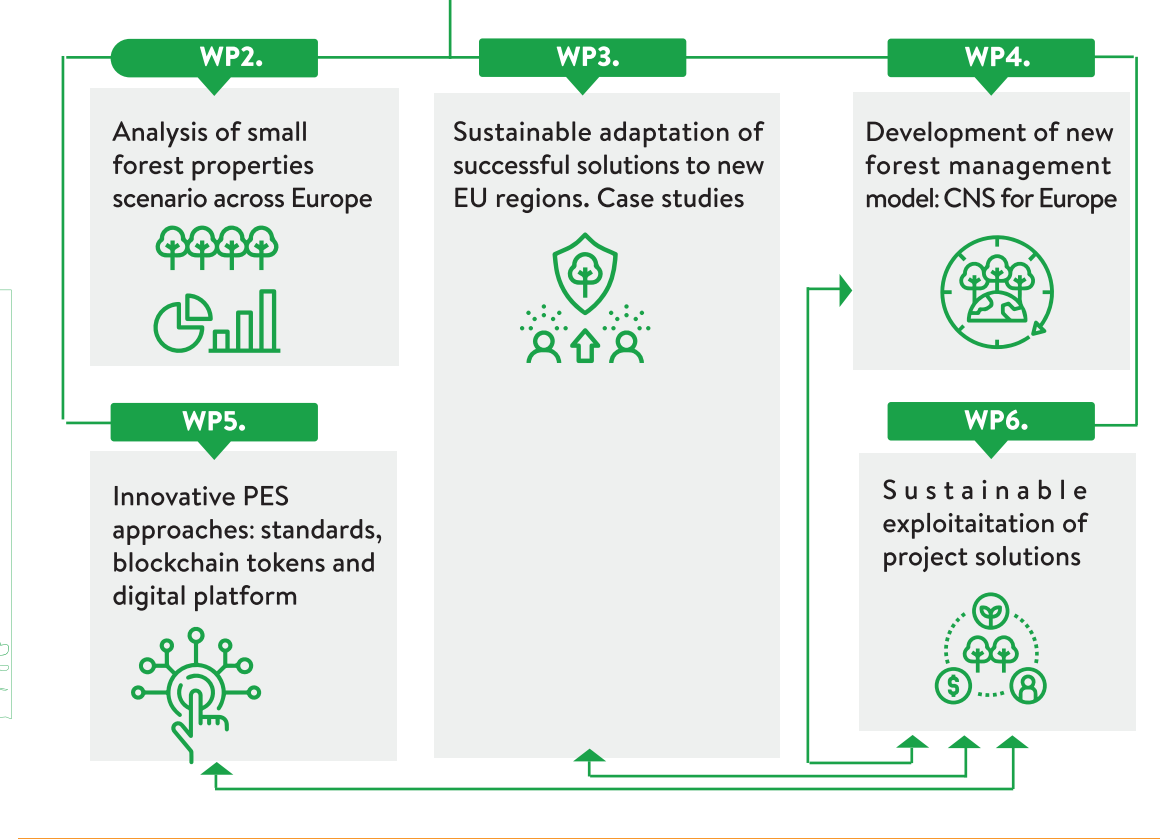
